

## Face masks in Carinthia / Austria

As of 14.09.2020, a face mask must be worn across Austria in the following situations:

- On all public transport and in taxis
- Across trade (both customers and staff), e.g. in the supermarket, at car dealers, in banks and at insurance companies
- At all service providers that involve customer contact (hairdressers, masseurs etc.)
- In public government buildings (e.g. courts and local authorities), including staff who deal with customers directly
- At swimming pools by swimmers and staff that come into indoor customer contact (with the exception of wet areas such as showers and in pools)
- Throughout the restaurant trade by staff that come into indoor customer contact
- At accommodation establishments (hotel industry) by guests and staff that come into customer contact within indoor communal areas. Catering regulations apply in restaurants
- Within sports facilities by guests and staff that come into indoor customer contact (except whilst practising sports)
- In museums, exhibitions, libraries, archives and all other leisure facilities by guests and staff that come into indoor customer contact
- At indoor events (except whilst sitting in your assigned seat)
- In cable cars, funicular railways, coaches and inside sightseeing boats
- At chemist's, in nursing homes, hospitals and health resorts, and in places where health and care services are provided
- At demonstrations when the 1 metre distance cannot be maintained

As of 21.09.2020, a face mask must also be worn in the following situations:

- At trade fairs (both indoors and outdoors)
- At markets (both indoors and outdoors)
- Across the restaurant trade by staff that come into customer contact and the customers themselves when not seated at their table

Note: Operators / service providers with customer contact and their staff only have to wear a face mask if there is no other suitable protective measure in place - such as a screen - that offers the same level of protection.
