1) Dogs are warmly welcomed in Carinthia!

However, please bear the following guidelines in mind to ensure a pleasant stay for you and your four-legged friend.

Legal matters

Please contact your veterinarian during the planning stage when preparing to go on holiday with your dog! The veterinarian can tell you precisely which documents, vaccinations, etc. will be necessary to enter your destination.

At border checkpoints, you should be able to show a valid EU pet passport and a valid rabies vaccination record.

You must bring a lead and a properly fitting muzzle with you during your stay in Austria and use these as needed.

There is no uniform nationwide lead and muzzle requirement for dogs in Austria; rather, this is regulated at the municipal level.

For more detailed information, it is recommended that you contact the municipal administration or tourism agency where you intend to stay. In general, your dog should always be on a lead when in public. (Snappish dogs must be on a lead and wear a muzzle!)

If your dog is not on a lead, please maintain control of the animal. Show consideration for cyclists, joggers, children and people who are not experienced with dogs. Please also take into account that many children do not know how to interact properly with dogs. Watch out for wild animals, particularly outdoors! (Mind snowy conditions that can make escaping difficult for wildlife, and take breeding seasons for animals into account!)

Identification

Every animal must be identified either with a clearly visible identification tattoo or with a microchip.

2) Swimming with your dog

In general, swimming in public bodies of water is prohibited according to the water regulatory authority.

However, there are some exceptions that are however subject to withdrawal.

Lake Wörthersee – Lake Keutschacher See

Dogs are prohibited from bathing at public bathing beaches at Lake Wörthersee.

Dogs are welcome guests at Lake Forstsee (except in some signposted areas), at Lake Techelsberger Kleinsee (north of Lake Forstsee), at Lake Trattnigteich (in certain areas) and at Lake Hafnersee (at separate dog beaches).

Some hotels have set a rule for their private beaches that dogs are only permitted on the beach and in the water early in the morning and in the evening.

Lake Keutschacher See:

- Dogs are welcome in the Strandcamping Süd beach camping area. Bathing is open to the public in the nearby bay!
- Next to the Strandcamping Süd area, there is a dog area where dogs can swim in the water at no cost.
- The FKK Grocamping Sabotnik camping area at Keutschach has its own dog area.
- Dogs can stay free of charge at the Brückler Nord campsite at Lake Keutschacher See! Visitors can also consult with a veterinarian (Dr Verena Seger) with an on-site veterinary practice at no charge. There is a separate bathing area for dogs, a dog shop for small everyday necessities (treats, literature by experts, food bowls, etc.) and regular events with in-house dog trainers.
- Dogs are always warmly welcomed throughout the family camping site premises at Lake Hafnersee/Keutschach.

Klagenfurt

You can find suitable bathing spots for dogs along the Sattnitz range.
There is a 'dog park' next to the Klagenfurt bathing beach.

Lake Faker See

In general, bathing is prohibited for dogs at Lake Faaker See.

Cycling with your dog

Cycling is a wonderful way to discover the diverse landscape of Carinthia. The atmosphere is created not only by the unique lake setting but also the well-maintained cycle path network that leaves no wish unfulfilled. You can also discover many routes together with your dog. The Drava Cycle Path R1 is especially lovely – and, not least, one of the best known cycle paths in the cyclist's paradise of Carinthia. It runs through impressive landscape from Sillian in East Tyrol across all of Carinthia to Lavamünd. Some sections of the route also occasionally offer the opportunity for your dog to cool off in the Drava River – perfect during the hot summer months!

The cycle tour that runs through the Lake Keutschacher Seental (R4 A) is especially beautiful and unspoilt. This route leads past Lakes Rauschelesee, Bassgeigensee, Keutschachersee and Hafnersee. Here in Austria's southernmost state, not only can you enjoy a distinctive natural landscape, but you can also find bathing opportunities that provide your four-legged friend with loads of fun.

Around Velden and Schiefing, dog owners can try out the Lake Wörthersee cycle tour. The route is far removed from the traffic on the state highway, offers a wonderful view of Lake Wörthersee and can also be mastered by those with less physical training due to the low altitude.
